The candidate must have:

- Cambodian language as their mother tongue.
- A degree in Khmer language studies and/or have undergone training in Khmer language teaching.
- As the institution's working language is French, a very good knowledge of this language is an important plus for the application.
- Not be a member of the Cambodian civil service.

The candidate must be:

- If possible, have previous experience in a similar position.
- Able to work as part of a team.
- Available for educational projects.
- Available for in-service training during the school year.

Teachers recruited under local contracts benefit from attractive pay and conditions:
